Course Description:

- Daily individual Instruction

Every course participant receives daily individual instruction on their respective instrument in the form of masterclasses. The masterclasses will focus on preparation for international competitions as well as repertoire preparation for concertizing as soloist and in recital. The mission of the course is to help prepare participants for the rigors of a professional career in music. Participants therefore have the opportunity to perform in public daily. The festival organizes one informal and one formal student concert every day for 7 days.

Every string player will have the opportunity to participate in orchestral audition training seminars. In addition, every participant will be assigned to a student chamber music group. Every student group will receive coachings and perform their assigned chamber music work during the festival. Participants will be notified of their chamber music repertoire and placement upon acceptance. The music will be sent to the student to facilitate preparation prior to arrival.

In keeping with the mission of the festival, all rehearsals are open to the public in order to give auditors insight into the creative process of concert preparation. Very advanced and experienced student participants may be selected to perform on the festival concerts in chamber music groups along with the faculty.
