Every course participant receives daily instruction on their respective instrument in the form of masterclasses. The mission of the course is to help prepare participants for the rigors of a professional career in music. Participants therefore have the opportunity to perform in public daily, enlarge their repertoire and gain experience in collaborative and orchestral performance.

Every string player will have the opportunity to participate in orchestral audition training seminars. In addition, every participant has the opportunity to participate in a chamber music group. Every student group will receive coachings and perform their chamber music work during the festival. Participants will be notified of their chamber music repertoire and placement upon acceptance. The music will be sent to the student to facilitate preparation prior to arrival.

In keeping with the mission of the festival, all rehearsals are open to the public in order to give auditors insight into the creative process of concert preparation. Very advanced and experienced student participants may be selected to perform on the festival concerts in chamber music groups along with the faculty.

Accepted participants are limited to 21 students in order to ensure the highest possible level of individual attention. We can accept 10 Violinists, 4 Violists, 3 Cellists, 2 Double Bassists and 2 Pianists.

COURSE FEES & OPTIONS:

750 € - (400 € Tuition und 350 € Room and Board für 11 Nights / 10 Days) The course fee includes daily instruction, chamber music coaching, orchestral audition training seminars, free admission to all festival concerts, as well as private (single room) accommodation and all meals in a restaurant in Aigues-Vives from August 4, 2013 to August 13, 2012.

400 € - 10-day course without accommodation and meals. The fee includes daily instruction, chamber music coaching, orchestral audition training seminars and free admission to all festival concerts. The Student must make his or her own accommodation and meal arrangements. This option is recommended for under-age participants accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Students must arrive on August 3, 2013 and depart August 14, 2013

Early arrivals and/or late departures cannot be accommodated by the festival.
