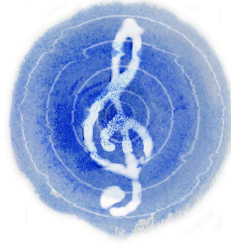

Course Description:

- **Daily individual Instruction**
- **Daily opportunities to perform in public**
- **Chamber music coaching and performance opportunities**
- **Orchestral audition training seminars for string players**

Every course participant receives daily individual instruction on their respective instrument in the form of masterclasses. The masterclasses will focus on preparation for international competitions as well as repertoire preparation for concertizing as soloist and in recital. The mission of the course is to help prepare participants for the rigors of a professional career in music. Participants therefore have the opportunity to perform in public daily. The festival organizes several informal, and one formal, student concert every day for 7 days.

Every string player will have the opportunity to participate in orchestral audition training seminars under the guidance of Friedemann Ludwig. In addition, every participant will be assigned to a student chamber music group. Every student group will receive coaching from Vladimir Stoupel and Stefan Fehland, and perform their assigned chamber music work during the festival. Participants will be notified of their chamber music repertoire and placement upon acceptance. The music will be sent to the student to facilitate preparation prior to arrival.

In keeping with the mission of the festival, all rehearsals are open to the public, in order to give auditors insight into the creative process of concert preparation. Very advanced and experienced student participants may be selected to perform on the festival concerts in chamber music groups along with the faculty.

COURSE FEES & OPTIONS:

750 € - This option is limited to 12 students! The course fee of **400 €** includes daily individual instruction, chamber music coaching, orchestral audition training seminar and free admission to all festival concerts. The additional **350 €** cover private (single room) accommodation and all meals at "Salle Jean Bosc" in Aigues-Vives from 04. August 2010 (arrival day) to 15. August 2010 (departure day) - 11 nights and 10 days.

400 € - 10-day course without accommodation and meals. The fee includes daily individual instruction, chamber music coaching, orchestral audition training seminars and free admission to all festival concerts. The Student must make his or her own accommodation and meal arrangements. This option is recommended for under-age participants accompanied by a parent or guardian.

55 €/day - suitable for students interested in coming for shorter periods than 10-days. The fee includes daily individual instruction, orchestral audition training seminars and free admission to all festival concerts. The Student must make his or her own accommodation and meal arrangements.
